Division Leader (Manager) Capital Projects

Reporting to the Corporate Leader (Director), Operational Services, the Division Leader (Manager), Capital Projects is responsible to manage and deliver a range of projects that support the development of and enhancements to the Municipality's transportation and infrastructure systems and facilities, as required. This position will provide oversight, technical expertise and leadership with a focus on capital projects from conception through design, approvals and construction.
